

CGI 2006 Global Health Commitment Statistics (as of October 2006)

- More than 65 total commitments on hand from major corporations and NGOs/Foundations, ranging in value from \$100,000 to hundreds of millions (over multi-year timeframes)
- Every major geographic region of the world touched by commitments:
 - Africa (East, West, and Sub-Saharan)
 - China
 - Southeast Asia, including India
 - Latin America
 - Russia and Eastern Europe
 - Middle East
 - Caribbean
- Content areas/themes include:
 - Infrastructure development (e.g. human, physical, transportation capacity strengthening)
 - Neglected Tropical Disease control and new drug development
 - Chronic disease prevention, treatment, monitoring
 - Environmental health factors (water, sanitation, hygiene education)
 - Extending efforts to combat HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, and malaria
 - Corporate-based community health programs
- Select examples of specific commitments
 - **UNICEF.** Major expansion of “accelerated childhood survival program” focused on HIV/AIDS prevention, diagnosis, and treatment as well as improved access to maternal and neonatal tetanus. Value: \$250m over a four-year period. Geographic region: Africa.
 - **Siemens.** Improve the quality of healthcare for rural Chinese communities by providing sophisticated (yet appropriate) medical diagnostic and water-purification technologies to rural health centers – including training to ensure their proper use and maintenance. Value: \$10 million over 5 years. Geographic region: China.
 - **DeBeers.** Provide health care, particularly relating to HIV/AIDS and malaria, to unlicensed small-scale miners and related industry workers in Tanzania as part of broad program aimed at long-term sustainable wellness, including prevention, education, training and fair pricing schemes. Value: \$6 million over 3 years. Geographic region: Africa.
 - **Teva Pharmaceuticals.** Donate generic antibiotics for treatment of lower respiratory infection in children. Value: \$5,000,000 over 3 years. Geographic region: South America.
 - **Merck.** Donate new Rotavirus vaccine to all children born in Nicaragua during the next three years, estimated to be 1.5 million doses. Value: \$75 million over 3 years. Geographic region: Latin America
 - **World Diabetes Foundation.** Develop multi-prong diabetes control program in South Africa, including school-based interventions, early identification and impaired glucose tolerance in HIV+ people, and improved quality of care in the Cape Town metro health services agency. Value: \$800,000. Geographic region: Africa.
 - **BRAC.** Provide increased access to health and economic opportunity by building a stronger infrastructure, training community health workers, and making health technologies affordable, and supported via BRAC’s holistic emphasis on microfinance, education, and agriculture inputs. Value: \$250 million over 10 years. Geographic region: Africa.
